To be eligible for this award the nominee must have been a MAHE member who has given meritorious service within MAHE related to one or more of the following:

- a. officer of MAHE or a MAHE local
- b. representative of MAHE on an MEA Board, committee or task force
- c. service on behalf of higher education on an NEA Board, committee or task force
- d. officer of MEA or NEA
- e. representative of higher education in political or organizing activity

Nomination may be made by any current or past MAHE member or by any MAHE local.
